### The Anne Mackie Award

To be considered for the Anne Mackie Award, nominees must meet the following criteria:

1. **Longevity** - A significant and long-term (at least 15 years) commitment to advocacy for women, above and beyond her profession.
2. **Leadership** - A commitment to advance one or more of the goals of NCWU, which are identified in four broad categories:
  - a. Access to Health Care
  - b. Civic Participation and Equality
  - c. Economic Self-Sufficiency
  - d. Violence Against Women
3. **Effectiveness** - Demonstrate work toward getting women to support each other and work together to minimize rivalry and competitiveness.
4. **Impact** - Demonstrate an ongoing effort to listen to, respect, honor, and include in her work diverse voices, regardless of politics, ethnicity, economics, religion, or gender.

Additional supporting material that can be documented and directly attests to the nominee's contributions, achievements, and character may be included. A minimum of two and no more than five, supporting letters or documents will be accepted; maximum length is 15 pages. No mass-produced materials should be included. All materials supporting the nomination will become the property of the NC Women United and will not be returned.

For your nominee to be considered, all materials (form, nominator's statement, and all supporting documentation) must be submitted by **5:00pm, FRIDAY, November 20**. **Electronic submissions to [mackieaward@ncwu.org](mailto:mackieaward@ncwu.org) are preferred.** You may also fax your materials to 1 -866-518-7657.
